

Future Simple I – Will

Will future expresses a spontaneous decision, an assumption with regard to the future or an action in the future that cannot be influenced.

Form of "will" future tense

Affirmative	Negative	Question
I will sleep.	I will not sleep.	Will I sleep?



Use of "will" Future Tense

- **a spontaneous decision.** Example: Wait, I will come with you.
- **An, opinion, uncertainty, hope or assumption regarding the future.** Example: He will probably go to Delhi tomorrow.
- **A promise.** Example: I will not work tonight.
- **An action in the future which cannot be influenced.** Example: It will rain tomorrow.

- **Conditional clauses type I** Example: If i arrive early, we will go for a movie.
